

The Flexitouch Plus system uses a programmable controller that connects to a garment with built-in air chambers. The garment inflates and deflates in a specific order, creating a gentle, wave-like motion. This mimics manual lymphatic drainage, moving excess fluid from the swollen area toward healthier parts of the body where it can be absorbed.
